SAESA group, our new ally

One of the major milestones this year was the signature of a contract with Copec that entered into effect in July. And we signed a new agreement in the second half of 2020, this time with the Saesa Group, for the supply of electricity to its unregulated customers in the south of the country. This electricity, a total of 600 GWh/year, will be generated by Likana Solar, equal to more than one-half of one of the towers in our project.



Sustainable energy series on “investments to confront climate change”

We held the first virtual Sustainable Energy discussion in September entitled “Investments to Confront Climate Change.” Mr. Juan Carlos Jobet, Minister of Energy, opened the discussion, followed by talks by Paula Estévez, general manager of AmCham, and Fernando González, CEO of Cerro Dominador. Benoit Felix, from Santander Corporate & Investment Banking; Marcelo Mena, director of Acción Climática (Climate Action) and former Minister of the Environment; and Francisco Alliende, Chief Executive Officer of the Saesa Group, were panel members.

The 11th version of the Clean Energy Ministerial (CEM) was held in Saudi Arabia. It is a global forum that brings together 27 countries that represent 90% of the world’s clean energy. As part of that forum, the “Women in Clean Energy: Harnessing All Talent” event was held at which the awards of the Clean Energy Education & Empowerment Initiative (C3E) were announced, Women of Distinction and Organizational Leadership. The Organizational Leadership Award was given to Cerro Dominador, the largest CSP project in Latin America that has been characterized by the important role that women have played in its construction.

This year we were twice honored in the National Environment Awards of Fundación Recyclápolis. We received both the 2020 “Fire” Award and the “Best of the Best” Award. Our plant might be a new Lego design



